Creating a Logo | Options:

1. Choose a ready-made template and edit it
2. Create your own custom logo using elements in Canva

Create Your Brand Kit (For Cohesiveness)

- Add logo (upload your newly created logo)
- Choose your brand colors
 - Hint: Download the Google Ext Color Pick Eyedropper
 - Search Pinterest for Color Palettes
 - Copy & Paste hex codes into brand colors

Brand Fonts

- Hint: Choose fonts you already use on your website or socials
- Search Pinterest for brand fonts and for complimentary fonts
- Upload custom fonts from dafont.com

Create Folders

How do you want to organize your projects?

- For example: Save your designs to these folders.
- Upload templates from others to folders

Using Templates

Uploading Templates From Others

1. Click on link to import
2. Make a copy of template you can edit
3. Save original to a folder and name it as Original

How to download a single page from the templates

1. Un-Select all pages checked
2. Choose page number to download and select it
3. Hit download
4. Check your design to see if it looks good

Workaround for editing the color of an element if it doesn't give you the option

1. Choose Edit Image
2. Select Duotone
3. Select any color option
4. Change both colors and apply
