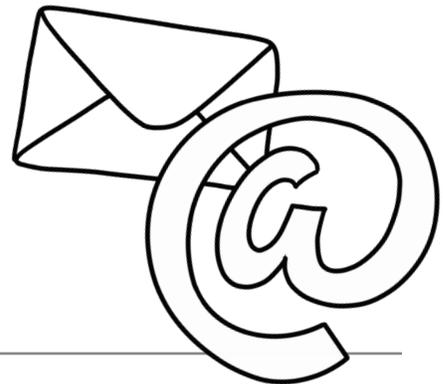

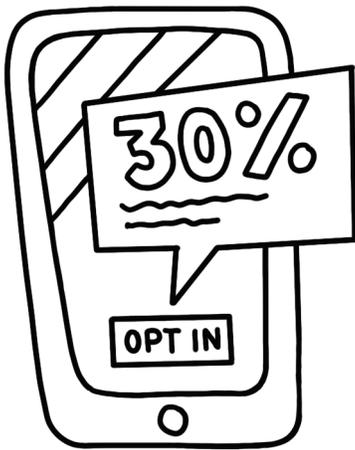

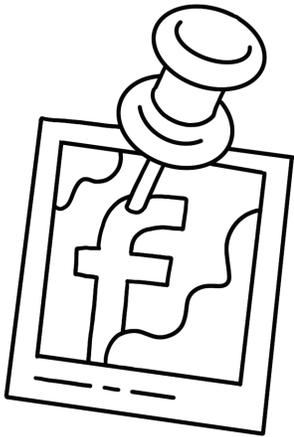

# Increase Email Openings

Let's be real—emailing your list is pointless if no one opens the darn thing. But the good news? You can totally boost your open rates with the right subject lines, a little curiosity, and just enough cleverness. In this lesson, we're diving into how to craft irresistible subject lines and what realistic open rates look like (spoiler: 15% is an A+ in email land). Get ready to test some headlines, steal some strategies, and make your emails the ones people *actually* click.

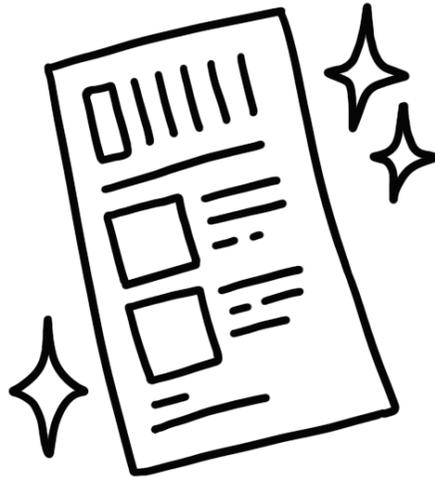

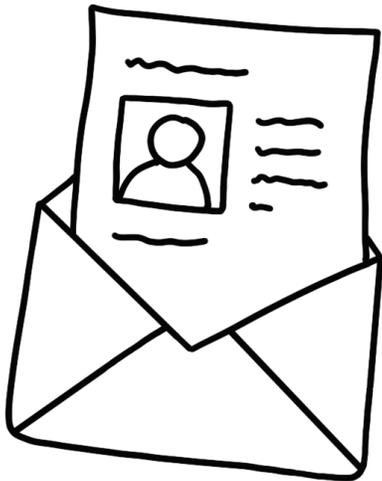

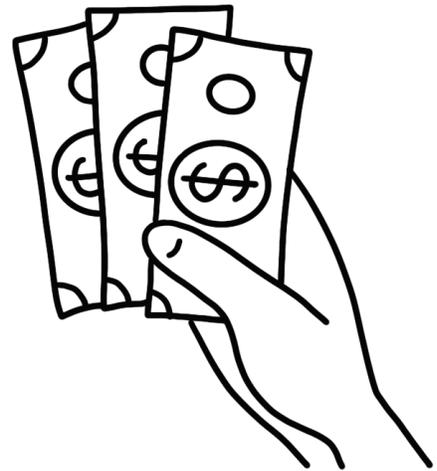

## Top 10 Glossary Terms for Beginners in E-Commerce

1. **Open Rate** – The percentage of email recipients who open a specific email, giving insight into how engaging your subject line and sender info are.
2. **Click-Through Rate (CTR)** – The percentage of email recipients who clicked on at least one link within your email, helping you measure engagement and interest.
3. **Subject Line** – The first line of text shown in someone’s inbox, designed to grab attention and convince them to open your email.
4. **Opt-In** – A process where a user willingly subscribes to your email list, usually through a form, pop-up, or freebie in exchange for their email address.
5. **Single vs. Double Opt-In** – Single opt-in adds users immediately after signup, while double opt-in requires them to confirm via email before being added to your list.
6. **Freemium** – A free resource (like a checklist, printable, or discount) offered to incentivize people to join your email list.
7. **Email Campaign** – A one-time email blast sent to your audience, often to promote a product, share updates, or drive traffic to a sale or event.
8. **Automation / Flow** – A series of emails triggered by a subscriber’s action (like signing up or making a purchase) that runs automatically behind the scenes.
9. **Scrub Your List** – The process of regularly removing inactive or unengaged subscribers to improve deliverability and reduce email provider costs.
10. **Friend Format** – A simple, conversational email layout that mimics an email from a friend—no flashy graphics, just a story, a few links, and a personal tone.
